<sup>1</sup> These limits apply to accounts registered with the FEC; different limits apply to a state or local party's non-federal accounts. All state and local committees of a political party in a state share a contribution limit for their federal accounts.

<sup>2</sup> Spouses have separate limits. Using a joint account, spouses can contribute to a candidate using a single check, but both spouses must either sign the check or sign an accompanying letter asking that the contribution be allocated between them.

<sup>3</sup> The primary, general, special, and runoff elections are each separate elections with separate contribution limits.

<sup>4</sup> A multicandidate political committee is defined as a political committee with more than 50 contributors which has been registered for at least six months and has made contributions to five or more candidates for federal office.
